

In June, the BIYC had its 100th Anniversary celebration with over 300 alumni including 40 Staff Commodores and 30 Staff Secretary Treasurers. There was reminiscing, fun stories, great food, entertaining games, and a good time was had by all. The day started with alumni registering and talking to each other. The ceremony started with the history of BIYC then all of the past Staff Commodores and Staff Secretary Treasurers were announced one by one. After, there were fun memories shared by 1942 Senior Staff Commodore Allan Beek. The Mayor of Newport Beach, Mayor Kevin Muldoon, signed the Proclamation of Centennial Celebration for BIYC that was shared during the ceremony. After the ceremony, the celebration moved from Mr. Beek's dock to the end of Turguiose. Where everyone ate, played games about the history of BIYC, and rekinded the friendships they've made at the BIYC beach over the years.

It's hard to keep the tradition alive in our changing world. That's what's so amazing about BIYC, it's tradition has carried on for 100 years. It has survived The Great Depression, World War II, the Vietnam and Korean Wars, 9-11, and a worldwide pandemic. In those years the world has seen the invention of color television, space travel, the internet, and TikTok.

There are a lot of things that have happened in 100 years, and BIYC continues. "Team Effort Cooks up "Best Memorial Day BBQ Ever"

Nearly 400 Attend Return of Annual Event

An Island favorite returned in grand style as the Memorial Day BBQ at Balboa island Park drew a record crowd of almost 400 people. "Greatest BBQ we've ever had. People just kept coming," **Bill Stewart** said. Stewart started the tradition and chaired this year's event.

The event is a dual effort – underwritten by the Balboa island Museum Newport Beach, which also provides many volunteers, runs the raffle, etc. All the BBQ essentials, from setup to breakdown, are courtesy of the **BALBOA ISLAND IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION**.

Museum Board Member **Dennis Bress** served as master of ceremonies, his wife **Summer Bress**, sang the "Star-Spangled Banner." "Much credit to Dennis and his son **Nigel**, Stewart said, they ran around buying all the food. Dennis even provided the Spam."

The food buying included an extra trip during the BBQ. "It was as if people started smelling good food, got on the Ferry and came on over," Museum Executive Director **Tiffany Pepys Hoey** said.

Many in the crowd were dressed in patriotic red, white and blue. Beyond the hot dogs and hamburgers, they came to honor those who have died in our nation's wars.

Deacon Patric Bartolic of Saint John Vianney Chapel read off the names of the 17 veterans lost since the last community Memorial Day gathering. They included:

- Eleanor Taylor, a WW II veteran and Navy nurse who was in the first group of WAVES.
- Sgt. Albert "Ally" Larsen, who escaped a well-documented "Nazi-death march."
- Pete Bonin Sr., 104, a WW Navy radioman and Bronze Star recipient.
- Air Force Veteran **Terry Donahue**, who went on to be head football coach of the UCLA Bruins for 20 years.

Stewart set up a wall of photos of Island Veterans in front of the Carroll Beek Center, which greeted visitors as they arrived.

The BBQ was free to veterans and their spouses, and all donations support the Museum's Veteran's Project. Stewart is the director of the Veterans Project, which has identified some 300+ veterans on the island, in its efforts to document and recognize all of them. About 180 Island veterans have shared their history at: balboaislandmuseum.org/veterans/

And Stewart's not done. "I still need a half dozen volunteers to make phone calls, knock on doors, find our new veterans, those who passed," Stewart said. Criteria are to have lived on the island or have some connection – the nation's most famous and decorated veteran, **Audie Murphy**, docked his boat here and spent time on Balboa Island.





Wow! Summertime on the Island hit like a tsunami. First, the BIIA sponsored the Twenty-Seventh Annual Balboa Island Parade on June 5, attracting over 4,000 people. That was followed by the onslaught of the Junior Lifeguards using the Island

as a shortcut to the morning and afternoon sessions on the peninsula. Also the advent of electric bicycles has enabled even more people to access the island without bringing cars.

For the first time, I'm hearing our Island neighbors saying much earlier than usual, "I can't wait to get our Island back." But that is just the result of us living and or working in a "Destination Location." We just have to realize it will take another five minutes to make it over the bridge.
